



Safety Measures On Board

At **Amare Nautical Tourism**, the safety of our passengers and respect for the environment are fundamental priorities. We want you to enjoy your trip along the Ría de Arousa and the Ulla River with complete peace of mind. Therefore, we ask that you follow these basic guidelines during navigation.

Onboard Safety

- Life jackets available: All our vessels are equipped with certified life jackets for both adults and children. Wearing one is not mandatory, but you can request one at any time if desired. In case of emergency, the crew will provide them to all passengers.
- **Emergency equipment:** On board we have fire extinguishers, flares, and a first aid kit, in accordance with current maritime regulations. These items are for the exclusive use of the crew in emergency situations.
- It is very important that all passengers follow the rules outlined below throughout the entire journey.
- Rules During Navigation
- **Remain seated:** For your safety, it is mandatory to remain seated throughout the trip, both during navigation and during boarding and disembarking maneuvers.
- **No smoking:** Smoking is not permitted on board at any time.
- Respect the environment: It is strictly forbidden to throw any object into the sea. Our commitment to the environment is strong, and we appreciate your cooperation.
- **Follow crew instructions:** The crew is trained to handle any situation. Always follow their guidance.

Child Safety

- We have life jackets specifically adapted for children.
- Children must always be accompanied by a responsible adult and must remain seated throughout the trip.
